### **Project objective**

The objective of the project is an increase in the competitiveness of the company DOMEL MEBLE PODŁOGI with the use of environmentally-friendly technological solutions so that the development of the company would proceed in a sustainable manner, however, be based on innovations. This objective will be achieved through the execution of activities leading to the implementation of solutions that are innovative with respect to all of Poland – a technological process and a product in the form of an industrial hardwood floor mosaic.

### **Planned project results:**

The execution of the project will allow the company to offer on the market an innovative product, with the assumptions of the project influencing a sevenfold increase in performance capacity and an increase in the company energy efficiency.

### **The role of Norwegian Funds and EOG funds**

Norwegian Funds and EOG funds represent the contribution of Norway into the creation of a Europe that is green, competitive and facilitating social integration.

Within the scope of Norwegian Funds and EOG funds, Norway is contributing to the reduction of social and economic differences and the tightening of bilateral relations with beneficiary states from Central and Southern Europe and the area of the Baltic Sea. Norway cooperates closely with
